Columbus Hilltop Lions Community Service Scholarship

Deadline: March 11

The Hilltop Lions Scholarship is for graduating seniors at one of the following Columbus, Ohio, area high schools: Bishop Ready High School, West High School, Briggs High School, and Franklin Heights High School. To qualify for this \$1,000 scholarship, applicants must have at least 30 hours of volunteer service between the end of their junior year and the application deadline date. [Application here.](#)

William D. Squires Scholarship

The William D. Squires Scholarship is primarily financial need-based, but ideal applicants have already selected a career goal and are highly motivated to reach their goal. The Scholarship Selection Committee also considers each student's academic promise. William D. Squires Scholarship applicants must be high school seniors from Ohio but may attend colleges outside of Ohio. The award amount has been increased from \$3,000 per year to \$4,000 and is renewable for a maximum total of \$16,000. Applications open February 15 and close on April 5. [Access application](#)

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

The HSF Scholarship is designed to assist students of Hispanic heritage obtain a college degree. Awards are based on merit; amounts range from \$500 to \$5,000, based on relative need, among the Scholars selected. Students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Legal Resident, DACA or Eligible Non-Citizen (as defined by FAFSA). As the nation's largest not-for-profit organization supporting Hispanic American higher education, HSF has awarded more than \$550 million in scholarships and provides a range of impactful programs for students, HSF scholars, alumni, and parents.
