The University of Notre Dame Summer Scholars participants spend two intense weeks in one of 21 programs of study. Classes are small so that students receive personal attention from Notre Dame faculty. The coursework is a true preview of college academics—it is both rigorous and rewarding, and students earn one college credit upon the completion of a program track. Cincinnatus XXI is a scholarship program based on academic ability, creative skills, and leadership potential.

The hallmark of the program is the Cincinnatus Presidential Award, a four-year award that covers full tuition, fees, room and board, and a book allowance. This award will be given to the top 10 candidates in the scholarship program. There is no separate application for the scholarship program. Youngstown State University Early SOAR

Students who apply and are accepted to YSU before February 15 will be eligible for EARLY-SOAR. This program allows students to be able to be among the first to register for classes allowing the best selection. Visit www.ysu.edu to apply.

Bowling Green State University Science & Math Scholarship

Science and Math Education in ACTION at BGSU offers 4-year scholarships and provides innovative opportunities to prepare the best science and mathematics teachers in the State of Ohio. This scholarship program is open to high school seniors considering teaching middle school science and math (grades 4-9), high school science, or high school mathematics. Recipients will receive \$4,000 the first year of college with increases each year of up to \$5,000 the fourth year, with a total award of approximately \$20,000. Requirements to apply for the program include:

- Admitted to Bowling Green State University
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Minimum composite score of 23 on the ACT
- Interest in teaching science and/or mathematics in grades 4 – 12
- Ohio resident

U.S. Department of State Merit-Based Scholarships

The U.S. Department of State provides over 1,000 merit-based scholarships each year for U.S. high school students to study abroad for a summer or an academic year in over 25 countries. These high school exchange programs prepare young Americans to succeed in the 21st century's global economy by developing their foreign language skills, increasing their cross-cultural understanding, strengthening their leadership capacity, and fostering new academic insights and ambitions. These scholarships include international airfare, tuition, and program costs, as well as meals and living accommodations (often with a host family). Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship

Award Amount: \$50,000 Deadline: November 15

The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2018-2019 competition. Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply. Male and female students compete separately. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need.

The University of Dayton ROTC Scholarship

Award Amount: Full Tuition Deadline: January 1

Army ROTC scholarships cover four, three, and two-year periods and provide for full tuition and charges, \$1200 a year for books, and a tax-free subsistence allowance of \$300 a month for first year cadets, \$350 a month for sophomore cadets, \$450 a month during the junior year, and \$500 a month in the senior year for up to ten months. An award up to \$5,000 is available, regardless of financial need. The Austin E. Knowlton Award is in addition to other academic merit scholarships and awards provided by the College. All Knowlton Scholarships are renewable annually.
